living out the gospel ... undercover

I am always intrigued by the idea of undercover police and what they are able to do by not being visibly identified as law enforcement officers. They still have the full role and responsibility of public officers but their stealth posture in all kinds of circumstances gives them a unique advantage and opportunity.

Similarly, undercover believers have a chance to live out the Message and share Christ among others, in a way that is different from those whose main way of identifying with Christ is by promoting congregational programs, Christian media, Christian Facebook posts and sometimes fish symbols on their car, etc.

My Dutch opa had a cousin who was part of the *underground resistance* in Holland during WWII, engaged in protecting Jewish people from the Nazis. Lives saved, but at a cost. He lost his life, betrayed by a Dutch collaborator with the Nazis.

Today, I believe we need a new army of *undercover Jesus followers* ... ones who can live in unbelieving, even hostile, environments with neutral identities where the light of the gospel shines relationally ...not through "big meetings, big budgets and big shots" as often passes for the church, as Neil Cole puts it. High visibility Christianity in the west has typically not been synonymous with disciplemaking, the movement of the gospel or spiritual generations. We must create new pathways.

But there is a cost. *Undercover believers* are often misunderstood, sometimes rejected, by Visible Christians. Yet, in a secularizing culture, where the church is on the margins, we believe the greatest need is to help more Jesus followers find pathways into daily living and 'Kingdom plant' there, where they are. For me, that has involved setting aside 26 years in a clergy identity and rebuilding with a marketplace identity, in my case renting office space to small businesses ... living missionally, touching many more lives than as a clergy.

Where do you *live*? Where are you *planted*? May God bless your undercover walk, work and witness!


